Plan to determine housing needs, market demand, and best practices



Special Improvement Districts Guidebook


The SID Guidebook was developed to inform interested parties about the benefits of forming a Special Improvement District, the general process of establishing one, and best practices for districts.

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What is a Master Plan?

- A long-term plan for how the community wants to grow and develop in the future
- Inventories what exists today and outlines the community's vision for the future
- Describes concrete action steps to achieve the vision

Why Plan?

- Provides the opportunity for community input
- Prepares the Village, residents, and businesses for the future
- Shapes future development to match your priorities
- Gives a **competitive advantage** when applying for grants and funding

This is the community's plan



How will the plan be implemented?

- Responsible parties are assigned to each action
- Actions are aligned with funding streams and are specified in grant applications
- The Plan is updated as circumstances and priorities change

What does it cover?

- Transportation
- Land use and zoning
- Housing
- Parks and the environment
- Economic development
- Industrial and business parks

Using the Master Plan

- ADOPT the Plan to make it an official policy
- USE the Plan as a tool and reference when considering actions and applying for grant funding
- UPDATE the Plan over time and when circumstances change







Total Population, 1950-2018




Population By Age







Road Network




Percent of Households by Number of Vehicles Owned, 2018








Existing and Proposed (Future) Bikeways










 - **Economic development**









Community Vision Objectives: Vision Statement and Objectives

The Village of Brooklyn Heights is a small village, but a big community that will employ the following guiding objectives:

- Redevelopment: Attract and retain strong businesses through a welcoming community.
- Connectivity: Develop an interconnected network to neighborhoods and districts while promoting and providing healthy alternatives for residents.
- Environment: Preserve environmentally sensitive areas.
- Regionalism: Enhance regional collaborations and partnerships.
- Housing: Maintain high residential standards that accommodate a broad and diverse range of lifestyles and stages of life.



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 Examples of action steps the community could utilize to move the Community Vision and Objectives forward

Community Vision Objectives: Redevelopment

Attract and retain strong businesses through a welcoming community:

- Zoning for existing businesses to stay in Brooklyn Heights
- Attractive business corridors
- Limit expansion of active landfills; explore redevelopment opportunities for closed landfills

Community Vision Objectives: Connectivity

Develop an interconnected network to neighborhoods and districts while promoting and providing healthy alternatives for residents:

- Paths to parks and other neighborhoods
- Connections Framework
- Connection to the Towpath and Cuyahoga River

Community Vision Objectives: Environmental

Preserve environmentally sensitive areas.

- Preservation of the river valley, West Creek, and surrounding open spaces
- Infrastructure systems that are adequate to meet future needs while protecting against disruptions like flooding
- Convert existing landfills for sustainable end uses
- Increase tree canopy with tree plantings
- Expand recreational opportunities within greenspaces

Community Vision Objectives: Regionalism

Enhance regional collaborations and partnerships.

- West Creek Conservancy
- Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District
- Cleveland Metroparks

Community Vision Objectives: Housing

Maintain high residential standards that accommodate a broad and diverse range of lifestyles and stages of life.

- Maintain existing housing stock
- Offer new construction housing options to serve specific segments of residents
- Offer housing options for older residents
- Market housing as first/starter homes






