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### INTRODUCTION


The City of Euclid partnered with the Cuyahoga County Planning Commission to undertake a Pedestrian & Bicycle Safety Action Plan. The plan focuses on improving active transportation options such as walking, biking, multi-modal, and other non-motorized mobility options. This report summarizes the kickoff community survey which was the first opportunity for residents to provide input on the plan.

#### **ABOUT THE SURVEY**

The Euclid Pedestrian & Bicycle Safety Action Plan community survey was open for two months from April 12<sup>th</sup> 2023 to June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The survey was hosted online with paper copies available at Euclid City Hall. In total, the survey was completed by 145 respondents, which included 1,505 answer selections and 818 written comments.

#### **NEXT STEPS**

The results of this survey and the comments provided by respondents in conjunction with other engagement efforts—including stakeholder interviews, focus group discussions, and input from community meetings—are being used to refine and inform the Pedestrian & Bicycle Safety Action Plan's analysis, recommendations, and implementation priorities.



### **TOP 10 THEMES**

Obtaining input from residents, stakeholders, and other community members was essential to helping shape policies and recommendations for this plan. The following 10 themes were the most common among respondents.



When asked to describe walking and biking in Euclid, "dangerous" and "unsafe" were the most common words used.



Sims Park and the new lakefront trail are recreational assets and the top destinations that respondents walk or bike to within the City of Euclid.



Most respondents walk or bike for recreation, health, and exercise; however, 50% of respondents also walk or bike out of necessity to get to work, school, and shopping destinations.



The primary reasons respondents do not walk or bike in Euclid are related to distance, weather conditions, safety concerns, and lacking or poor infrastructure.



66% of respondents would support slightly longer car trips if it meant roads in Euclid were safer for pedestrians and bicyclists.



80% of respondents would be willing to walk more than a half mile and 75% of respondents would be willing to bike more than a mile if safer, more convenient pedestrian and bicycle facilities were installed in Euclid.



55% of respondents indicated they are dissatisfied with Euclid's existing facilities for walking and biking.



The most desired changes in Euclid regarding both bicycle and pedestrian experiences are expanding all-purpose trails/paths, creating walkable shopping areas, and adding bike lanes.



32% of respondents with children attending k-12 schools in Euclid are not comfortable letting them walk or bike to school.



73% of respondents agreed that it is important for Euclid to focus on becoming a more bike and pedestrian friendly community and that they would like to be able to travel more easily and safely to destinations in Euclid without a car.




#### **AGE OF RESPONDENTS**




#### LENGTH OF RESPONDENT EUCLID RESIDENCY



### **RESPONDENT GENERAL HOME LOCATIONS**








#### FREQUENCY OF TRANSPORTATION METHODS




#### PRIMARY PURPOSE FOR WALKING OR BIKING IN EUCLID



#### TOP DESTINATIONS RESPONDENTS LIKE TO VISIT IN EUCLID




#### RESPONDENT AGREEMENT OR DISAGREEMENT WITH THE FOLLOWING STATEMENTS




#### REASONS FOR **NOT** WALKING OR BIKING


#### REASONS FOR FEELING UNSAFE

## **PRESENCE** OF K-12 CHILDREN THAT WALK OR BIKE TO SCHOOL IN EUCLID



## RESPONDENT <u>COMFORT</u> FOR LETTING THEIR CHILD WALK OR BIKE TO SCHOOL IN EUCLID





#### ADDITIONAL COMMENTS ABOUT BIKING AND WALKING IN EUCLID

Total responses to this question: 61

Address speeding through monitoring and enforcement: "Euclid needs to start enforcing the speed limit on Lakeshore Blvd. The speed limit is 25 and 35 mph but people drive 50 mph." "I think a permanent, solar powered speed limit monitor sign in downtown Euclid would be helpful and/or large, wide speed bumps similar to E. 174th Street in North Colinwood."

Improve sidewalk quality and paths:

"Tripping on uneven sidewalks is always a worry. I've tripped twice on uneven pavement and though I wasn't hurt the outcome might have been different."

"More attention should be dedicated to enabling people to walk safely for recreation, small errands, and exercise."

Location specific comments:

"I work with seniors in Euclid and a lot of them do not have cars. They are not able to make it down the hill on Richmond Road in order to do their grocery shopping so they have to take public transportation or have some

"Need more crosswalks on E. 200<sup>th</sup> Street."

"For my bike commute, the most dangerous spot is southbound at E. 222<sup>nd</sup> Street and St. Clair Avenue" "I feel like I live in a very walkable neighborhood. I have family that live close in Euclid that I would love to walk and visit, but the intersections at Lakeland Boulevard and E. 200th Street, the I-90 underpass and St. Clair Avenue at E. 200th Street all seem unsafe."
